

## **WorldSkills UK Training Managers needed for WorldSkills 2015**

### **Do you have what it takes to train the UK's most highly skilled young people for WorldSkills São Paulo 2015?**

At WorldSkills Leipzig (July 2013) Team UK put in a world class performance showcasing the skills of young people in this country, bringing home two Gold, one Silver, three Bronze Medals and 17 Medallions for Excellence in skills ranging from Bricklaying, Autobody Repair and Aircraft Maintenance.

WorldSkills UK hopes to achieve similar success at the next WorldSkills Competition which takes place in São Paulo, Brazil, in 2015. To do this, the help of the UK's best industry experts is needed to train the UK competitors and ensure they are ready to compete against their peers from over 60 countries.

Expressions of interest will shortly be invited for Training Manager/WorldSkills Expert positions for WorldSkills São Paulo 2015 for the skills listed below. Interested applicants are encouraged to apply on the basis of their demonstrable attributes, which may have been developed in a wide range of vocational and or occupational settings. Applications are requested by an Expression of Interest (Eoi) and submission of CV in the first instance which addresses the role description and person specification.

All current (Worldskills Leipzig 2013 cycle) Training Managers/WorldSkills Experts are required to reapply for their position as stated above with a letter of application and CV.

Application process commences from Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> October and the closing date for all applications is Monday 21 October at 12 noon. Interviews will commence for all roles week commencing Monday 28 October 2013 in various locations throughout the UK.
